

Church-School quick audit

Use this checklist to audit your existing links with schools and to identify additional areas in which your church can operate.

In each section it may be helpful to think about what follow up action immediately comes to mind. It may be something as simple as checking the information with someone in another church. Challenge yourself to put a deadline on each action, plus (if working in a group) the name of the person who will do it. Hopefully in this will provide a way forward so that this doesn't merely remain a paper exercise.
